Backing

Quilts By Commission Price Sheet

Fabric washing - \$4.50 per large load

Overall Design, Fabric Preparation, Cutting, Piecing and Applique design and prep. - \$18.00 per hour

Fabric and Specialty Thread cost including backing and binding fabric is dependent on needs.

Hand stitching - \$20.00 per hour

Hand Tying – includes every 4 to 6 inches depending on quilt need - \$20.00 an hour

Hand Quilting – long term commission with no specific due date obtainable – \$20.00 per hour

QBC does “All over designs” (this includes Meander), “All over and special border designs”, and “Custom”.

QBC orders your batting. At wholesale cost, with NO upcharge. Orders come from Quilter’s Dream Batting. There are few exceptions to this rule, ask and I’ll see if QBC can accommodate what you have...once you get a Quilter’s Dream Batting in your quilts you’ll never go back! Wall hangings may need 2 battings according to design. At your first consult for long arm quilting you may be shown how to make your backings for future projects.

Backing Size requirements:

Advanced quilter (Perfect borders, you know who you are!) – 4” extra all the way around

Intermediate quilter (Sometimes you have a Rhombus of a quilt, or wonky borders when you do mitered borders) – 5” extra all the way around

Beginning Quilting (Absolutely new to quilting – free tutorial on how to put binding on your quilt!) – Take your quilt top size and add 6” on EACH SIDE

Example: Quilt top = 40 inches by 50 inches

 + 12 +12

Backing 52 inches by 62 inches

Long arm quilting services are customized for every quilt without any extra cost! Each quilt will be evaluated, and the customer's needs will always be the focus. \$35.00 Minimum for any long arm project.

Discounts for 2 or more projects at the same time are available. You get back ALL Scraps from your backings and batting, and your quilt will be trimmed for you! Understand that with t-shirts or other embellishments on your quilt it may be impossible for the machine to go over every inch of your quilt, this will be determined at the consult. All "plasticity" fabrics must be on the top of your quilt.

Price Per Inch:

\$.018 per square inch = "Just get it together" Large Meander

\$.02 per square inch = Medium Meander or large all over design

\$.05 per square inch = One color thread, multiple designs (usually one design on the inside block work and then another design in the border area)

\$.10 per square inch = Quilt show quality Custom - multiple thread colors

Any markings will be made with a chalk or water-soluble pen and removed before delivery of your quilt.

Postage/Handling will be billed to client in final invoice. QBC uses USPS for all shipping.

Any Fabric research online or in local quilt shops will be charged NY minimum wage (\$12.00 per hour).

Any travel out of the immediate Auburn, NY area will be billed \$.58 per mile, door to door. This includes to fabric shops. Any time spent at an event will also be billed \$15.00 per hour while working at event; this does not include set up and clean up.

Estimates will reflect prior quilting projects; the final cost will be assumed when all work is completed. If a commission is longer than 4 weeks to completion, additional deposits may be requested. A Client's Budget will be considered, but with many factors in the commission process no estimate is guaranteed. All commissions, unless noted by Client, will be featured on the QBC Facebook page as a complete album to share with friends and family. All prices and quotes do not include applicable taxes. (8%)

All commissions come on a First come First serve basis. Shorter Deadlines may accrue additional fees, especially from October 1st to December 24th. QBC requests all Holiday orders before October 1st each year. QBC is a smoke free studio. QBC does not accept any items from a smoker's home for t-shirt or memory quilts. QBC is a pet dander free studio. QBC requests that all items from a pet friendly home are washed well before bringing into the studio.
